COOKIES POLICY

Welcome to RAUVA.

This policy explains how we use cookies and similar technologies on our website https://rauva.com/.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (such as a computer or smartphone) by your browser at the request of a website you visit. Some cookies are essential for the functioning of the website (e.g. security or session management), while others help improve your user experience or gather analytical and marketing insights. Cookies may be session-based (deleted after you close your browser) or persistent (stored for a longer period). Depending on their content and usage, cookies may be used to recognize you as a user across sessions.

2. HOW DO WE USE COOKIES?

We rely on our legitimate interest to use strictly necessary cookies. All other types of cookies (analytics and marketing) will only be used with your prior consent, which you can manage via our cookie management panel.

We use three types of cookies: strictly necessary cookies, analytics cookies and marketing cookies:

- Strictly necessary cookies these cookies are essential for navigation on the website and its features, such as access to restricted areas of the website, on RAUVA's legitimate interest.
- Analytics Cookies these cookies provide statistics about the use of the website.
- Marketing cookies these cookies allow us to create profiles and personalize content.

The legal basis for the processing of personal data using cookies for analytics purposes is the consent of the user Art. 6 (1) (a) GDPR.

The use of the analytics cookies aims to improve the quality of RAUVA's website and its contents. Through the analytics cookies, we learn how the website is used and so we can constantly optimize our offer.

3. THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

Third-party cookies may be stored on your device by your browser when you use our Website (e.g., analytics services). These cookies are placed by our service providers, and they may collect information about your browsing habits on our Website and other websites that you may visit.

A full list of third-party cookies and their providers is available in our Cookie Management Panel. You may review or change your consent preferences at any time by clicking the "Manage Cookies" link at the bottom of the website.

4. WHAT INFORMATION WE COLLECT THROUGH COOKIES

When a user accesses our websites, <u>cookies are stored on its computer and transmitted to our side</u>. This information may include your IP address, browsing history, location data, device ID and device type. We process this information according to our <u>Privacy Policy</u>, which outlines how we collect, use, and share your personal information. We will not use this information for any other purpose than what is described in our Privacy Policy.

We also do not share your personal information collected through cookies with third parties, except as outlined in our Privacy Policy. For optional cookies, you can withdraw your consent to the use of cookies and similar technologies at any moment.

The retention period which cookies remain on your device depends on their purpose, typically ranging from a few minutes (e.g. session cookies) to up to 24 months for analytics cookies.

5. HOW CAN YOU CONTROL COOKIES?

You can withdraw or modify your consent at any time via our Cookie Settings panel, accessible from the footer of the website. You may also adjust your browser settings to block or delete cookies, though this may impact certain website features. If cookies are disabled for our website, it may not be possible to use all the functions of the website to the full.

6. AMENDMENTS TO THIS POLICY

We may update this Cookies Policy periodically to reflect changes in our internal practices, technologies, legal requirements, or for other operational reasons. If material changes are made, we will notify users via a banner or email (where applicable). The revised policy will indicate the date of the last update.
